This week we have had several exciting visitors to school. For Science Week, all the children were witness to an assembly run by Sue Heywood full of weird and wonderful experiments.

They were then all involved in workshops that fitted in with their current science topic. Children in EYFS, Y1 and Y2 looked at the life cycle of a butterfly and made the life cycles using jelly sweets and tissue paper! They also enjoyed wrapping each other up in paper to make a chrysalis.

Year 3 and 4 conducted various different experiments to investigate sound and vibration and Year 5 and 6 who are studying adaptation, had to adapt their hand using either a spoon, a peg or tweezers to pick up sweets and different food substances. This proved to be an incredibly exciting and hands on day.

Year 3 were also visited by the fire service to learn about fire safety and Jake Evans, a storyteller, worked on storytelling workshop with our Year 6 pupils in order to inspire them to tell and write their own creative stories.
